All Categories-

Taste, Tenderness, and Appearance

Contestants should submit enough portions for **6** judges to score.

All entries will be turned into officials in a 92x92 unmarked Styrofoam container.

Containers will be supplied.

Containers that appear to be marked will not be judged.

Nothing should be visible from outside of turnin container.

Sauces and dips: must be **cooked** on or in the entry.

Sauce will not be judged.

Judging will be blind.

All entries will be submitted to event officials under team number supplied by an event official.

Garnishments are optional, but limited to GREEN Leafy Plant Material, is Lettuce, Parsley, Celantro, etc...

Contestant packets will be supplied to each team.

Cooking apparatuses can be homemade or commercially built.

Cookers shall only be fueled with: wood, charcoal, or pellets.

No wood, charcoal or pellets will be supplied. Electricity will be limited, so all cooks should be prepared to supply their own electricity.

No pets allowed in the cooking areas.

All cooking and preparation must be done in the open. (No cooking or preparations in motor homes, campers, enclosed tents, or enclosed trailers.)

Assigned cook sites are for chief cooks, assistants and guest.

Chief cooks are responsible for the conduct of those in his/her assigned area.

Chief cooks shall not share cookers or assigned areas, and are required to keep all equipment inside of their areas.

All meats shall arrive raw. Meats **cannot** be premarinated, pre-rubbed, pre-basted or prespiced, before being inspected by an official. Pre-mixing spices and marinades **are** allowed. All meats must be properly stored (below 40 degrees F, prior to cooking, above 140 degrees F, after cooking)

Teams are responsible for their own cooling equipment, ice, coolers, etc?

Proper handling of all ingredients is REQUIRED (vinyl or latex gloves should be worn)

Cooking utensils must be kept sanitized (1 cap of bleach to 1 gal. of water)

This Year the Vietnam Memorial Wall Replica will be erected along the River Park. We RESPECTFULLY INSIST:

Shoes and shirts be worn by all contestants. (*Fun, festive or dress of a specific era is*

encouraged.)

Any alcoholic beverages used for cooking or any other purposes be utilized in un-marked containers. No serving of alcoholic beverages to the public.

No foul or abusive language.

No fighting or disorderly conduct.

Loud radios or excessive noise will not be allowed.

Any violation of the event rules must be reported to an event official.

Quiet time begins at 11:00 p.m. 2 Any violation of the event rules must be reported to an event official.
